**Doctor's Degree-Professional Practice:** A Ph.D. or other advanced work beyond the master's level including the preparation and defense of a dissertation based on original research, or the planning and execution of an original project demonstrating substantial artistic or scholarly achievement. Examples include, but are not limited to:

At WVU, the Doc-Professional Practice category includes: EdD, JD, DDS, MD, PharmD, DNP, DPT, AuD,

**Doctor's Degree-Other:** A doctor's degree that does not meet the definition of a Doctor's Degree-Research/Scholarship or Doctor's Degree-Professional Practice

**Master's Degree:** An award that requires the successful completion of a program of study of generally one or two full-time equivalent academic years of work beyond the
