### ECAS ABM Policy:

In addition to the University guidelines/policy for Accelerated Bachelor's/Master's Programs presented here - [Programs, Courses & Credits < West Virginia University \(wvu.edu\)](#), the College would implement additional guidelines as follows:

- Students (including students admitted to an ABM program) may enroll in only one 500-level course per semester while enrolled as an undergraduate student.
- Students must be evaluated and admitted to the ABM program by the end of their sophomore year in the bachelor's degree.

- Students admitted to an ABM program must complete one 500-level course per semester beginning in their junior year.
